

# Special instructions for the primary election

YOUR BALLOT HAS 2 SIDES.

Primary contests for the 3 major political parties in the state are on one side. You can only vote for candidates from one political party. Vote in only one column on this side. Contests on the other side are not party-based, and you can vote on all of them.

- Primary contests for the 3 major parties (Independence, Republican, & Democratic-Farmer-Labor) are on the front side of the ballot.

**Vote in only one column for contests in one party.**

**Voting in more than one column means your votes on the front of the ballot cannot be counted.**
