

Welcome to your new home

With so much to do when moving to a new home, some things can get lost in the shuffle. Don't let registering to vote be one of them. Even if you've registered before, now that you have a new address you need to update your registration.

A voter registration application is included with this information. Making sure you are ready for the next election starts with getting registered today. You can:

- Complete the included application and return it through the mail, or
- Complete the online registration application at vote.minneapolismn.gov/renter.

You are eligible to register and vote in Minnesota if you are:

- A United States citizen.
- At least 18 years old on Election Day.
- A resident of Minnesota for 20 days before Election Day.
- Finished with all parts of any felony sentence.
- See all eligibility requirements at vote.minneapolismn.gov

*If you miss the pre-registration deadline, you can still register and vote at the polls on Election Day. Please see vote.minneapolismn.gov/voters/ELECTION-DAY-REGISTER for the required proofs of address and identity. Pre-registering saves time and the need to bring any additional documents to the polls.
