Assistance from election judges

- ▶ If you need help marking your ballot, two election judges from different political parties can assist.

Rules for assistants who are not election judges

- ▶ Your assistant cannot ask or persuade you to vote for a particular party or candidate.
 - ▶ Your assistant cannot reveal your choices—or anything that took place while helping you—to anyone else.
 - ▶ Your assistant cannot help more than three voters physically mark a ballot. Assistants can help in other ways, such as verbal translation, an unlimited number of times.

You cannot help a voter in the voting booth if you are:

- ▶ the voter's employer or an agent of the voter's employer;
- ▶ an officer or agent of the voter's union;
- ▶ or a candidate for election.
