How to complete a ranked choice ballot

STEP 1:



Choose your top candidate. This is your 1st choice candidate and will be the vote that is considered first.



STEP 2:



If you have a 2nd choice (not required), you may select another candidate. This must be different from your 1st choice candidate.



STEP 3:



If you have a 3rd choice (not required), you may choose another selection. This must be different from your 1st and 2nd choices.

How votes are counted:

All 1st choice votes are counted. If no candidate has the required number of votes to win, candidates that have the fewest votes are eliminated. This process continues until a candidate has enough votes to win. Election officials only use your 2nd or 3rd choice if your 1st choice has already been eliminated.
